The What & Why of School Choice Giving All Children a Chance at Success

Historical & Social Drivers

- Parental School Choice: The Civil Rights Issue of this Century
- Zip Code should not dictate education and opportunity
- Location, Poverty and Lack of educational choices travel together

Legal Drivers

- Open districting helps those who can afford to move
- Choice beyond public schools requires funding
- Historic legal bias for public schools

Why We Must be Advocates?

- The Deck is Stacked
 - Statutory basis for public education legally entrenched
 - Public funding of primary & secondary education through taxes and bonding
- The demographics of neighborhoods and education
- Constitutional Bias: The Blaine Amendment

Arizona Constitution: *The Blaine Amendments*

- "No public money or property shall be appropriated for or applied to any religious worship, exercise, or instruction, or to the support of any religious establishment." Arizona Const. Art. II, Section 12
- "No tax shall be laid or appropriation of public money made in aid of any church, or private or sectarian school, or any public service corporation." Arizona Const. Art IX, Section 10
- Arizona Courts have <u>not</u> interpreted Blaine Amendments expansively.


What & How: Building Coalitions to Give All Children a Chance

- Legislative Framework gives choices
- Three major Parent options
 - Individual Tax Credit
 - Corporate Tax Credit
 - Educational Savings Accounts
- Catholic Education Arizona
 - \$100MM paid out, 72K Awarded
 - 99% Grad/97% College Rate
