Mission Statement

The mission of the Board ("Mission") is to support the Roman Catholic Diocese of Phoenix ("Diocese") and the Bishop in the faith formation of children in the diocesan Catholic schools, leading them to an encounter with the living Christ, integrating faith throughout an educational process that promotes academic excellence, moral values, and lifelong service.

General Purpose

To further its Mission, the Board advises and consults with the Catholic Schools Office of the Diocese ("Catholic Schools Office") and the duly-appointed Superintendent of Catholic Schools of the Diocese ("Superintendent"), and recommends appropriate policies to assist the Superintendent and the Bishop in meeting the Canon Law responsibilities regarding the establishment and direction of the Catholic schools throughout the Diocese (collectively, the "Schools").

<u>Goals</u>

- 1. To promote strong Catholic identity by supporting the Diocese and the Bishop in the faith formation of children in Diocesan Catholic schools.
- 2. To assist local school boards to operate effectively and efficiently.
- 3. To pursue affordable Catholic Education.
- 4. To enhance overall communication about Catholic schools.
- 5. To promote and celebrate excellence in Catholic education.

DIOCESAN SCHOOL BOARD COMMITTEES

CATHOLIC IDENTITY

This committee facilitates the nourishment of the spiritual dimension of the Board's work and gives Diocesan School Board members the time and opportunity to pray together, to reflect on the Scripture, to share faith and to celebrate the Eucharist. It serves as a model to local school boards on the importance of keeping the Catholic faith in board operations through various resources and activities. The committee is also an advocate for matters pertaining to our faith.

EXECUTIVE (Required per DSB Constitution)

This committee consists of Diocesan School Board Officers – President, Vice President, Secretary, Past President and (optional) one member at large. Its responsibilities include developing the vision and strategy for the Board, advising the Bishop and Superintendent, setting the agenda for the monthly Board meetings and evaluating the effectiveness of the Board.

Legislative Action Network (LAN)

This committee gathers information on state and federal legislation which impacts Catholic Schools. With the guidance and direction of the Arizona Catholic Conference, the committee communicates with the Diocesan School Board and the media (Diocesan Communications Office) on legislative issues and promotes advocacy for Catholic Schools and school choice. CPAN works directly with the Arizona Catholic Conference on the annual Catholic Schools Week Rally and Mass.

FINANCE (Required)

This committee reviews the Diocesan high school budgets, financial statements, enrollment reports, annual audits and consulting services used to ensure strong financial health and internal controls of the schools. The committee reviews high school capital projects, long term financing, loan submissions, IT software (such as accounting and payroll) and financial contingency plans. It also aids in the analysis of Diocesan teacher and administrative salaries.

MARKETING/COMMUNICATION

This committee finds ways to share good news of Catholic education via social media. It coordinates promotes Catholic Schools Week events, and positive communication between the schools and the Diocese.

NOMINATION/IN-SERVICE/LSB NETWORKING (Required)

This committee organizes regularly-scheduled in-service meetings for Catholic schools in the Diocese of Phoenix. It provides orientation for new Diocesan School Board members, advertises for prospective Board applicants, interviews them, and makes recommendations to the Superintendent. This committee is designed to work with individual school boards to facilitate networking meetings within the Diocese; these meetings foster the sharing of best practices, challenges, and successes among all the school boards.

NIGHT OF HOPE COMMITTEE

This committee consists of a Chair/Co-Chairs as well as members of both the Diocesan School Board and the Catholic community-at-large. Its purpose is to plan the annual Night of Hope event, in celebration of Catholic schools in the Diocese of Phoenix. The primary purpose of this event is to raise money to provide scholarships to students seeking a Catholic education.
