In a large group, discuss the following:

- 1. Cardinal Virtues
 - Prudence –the ability to judge between actions with regard to appropriateness (wisdom)
 - Fortitude the ability to confront fear, uncertainty and intimidation (courage)
 - Justice balance between selflessness and selfishness (fairness)
 - Temperance the practice of self-control; moderation (chastity)
- 2. Go over examples from some of the students' media logs.

3. Discuss

- What do these examples from our culture say about human dignity?
- How do these examples contradict the cardinal virtues?
- What are some examples of how human dignity can be elevated in our culture?
- What are some examples of how cardinal virtues are upheld in our culture?
- What can you do this week to help uphold human dignity or any of the cardinal virtues?
- 4. Have all students write down a personal philosophy statement reflecting how they will live out the cardinal virtues in response to media and culture.

Closure:

Closing prayer (two different options are below) **Prayer Option 1** – (Blessed John Henry Newman)
